## Who Can Become a Tutor?

*Persons, 21 years of age or older, interested in improving someone's life by serving as a volunteer tutor to help an adult increase their reading and writing skills, or teach English as a second language. Prior teaching experience or fluency in another language is not required. A good command of the English language and grammar is required. A tutor must pass a background check before beginning to work with students.*

## What will I learn?

*This training provides instruction in initial strategies to teach adult learners English reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. Students may be English speakers with basic literacy skills or non-English speakers seeking to improve their communication skills. Training is ongoing and requires trainees to observe 3 classes following the 6-hour orientation. A training chair and other experienced tutors provide continuous support. This is a one-on-one or small group program for adult students in upper Pinellas County.*
